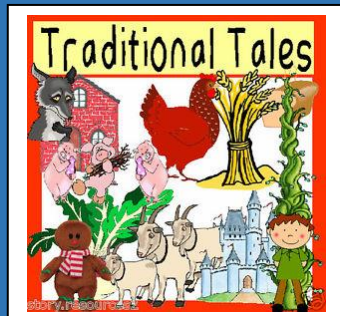

Curriculum Overview Green Class Spring 2017 Our topic is: Traditional Stories



What will we be learning this term

English

This term we will be reading traditional stories.

We will be retelling the stories using puppets and in our role play theatre.

In phonics we will be learning the **phase 3** sounds and tricky words and using these sounds to read and write simple sentences.

RE

We will be looking at how people celebrate and finding out about Easter.

Music

Our Topic this term is Everyone. Children will be listening to different songs finding the pulse, playing rhythm games, exploring high and low pitch and creating their own sounds.

Maths



Children will learn:

- To recognise numbers 0-20
- To count a collection of object.
- To compare two groups of objects and say which one is more.
- To add two numbers.
- To subtract two numbers.
- To solve problems.
- To recognise 2D and 3D shapes
- To talk about size, weight, capacity and time..

Science

Knowledge and understanding of the World

We will be talking about the similarities and differences between themselves and others.

We will be looking at animals and plants and talking about changes.



Art and DT

This half term children will:
Look at paintings by Paul Klee

- To paint a picture in the style of Paul Klee using 3 steps.
- To choose their own materials to produce their own version of some of his art work.



History and Geography

We will be looking at the similarities and differences between places.
We will compare where we live to other parts of the world.
We will look at and draw simple maps.
