## What will we be learning this half term



### English

We will be doing lots of writing again, particularly diaries and newspaper reports.

All the time we will be looking to use

- Full stops, question marks, exclamation marks
- Capital letters
- Apostrophes
- Commas in lists
- Expanded noun phrases (adjectives)
- Conjunctions (e.g. and, but, because)

### RE

We are learning to understand how celebrating Passover help God they value their speci with Him.



### Maths

- Adding two 2 digit numbers
- Learning our 2, 5, and 10 times tables
- Looking at fractions of numbers (1/2s, 1/3s, 1/4s)
- Time (half past and quarter past)



### ICT-E safety

Children will learn what communication tools are, how to communicate correctly with peers and what to do if they find anything they are worried about



### Science

In Science we will be looking at materials, their properties and their suitability for different purposes.
