World Book Day- Friday 6th March 2020

Friday 6th March is World Book day at Fir Bank school and we have lots of book themed activities planned for the children.

The theme this year is 'Favourite literary character'. The children are invited to come to school dressed as a character from their favourite book and bring in the book to school to share with others.

We would like to encourage our children at Fir Bank to read for pleasure and fun; to be able to lose themselves in another world through the words and pictures of books. We also would like them to share their love of reading with others.

Therefore, three of the activities organised for the day are:

Book Swap: children bring in a book from home (one they have already read and appropriate to their age group) wrapped and labelled with a brief description (no title or spoilers please). Children bringing in a book may take part in the book swap and will bring home a different title to read.

Book Bingo- Reception to Year 6: children complete different activities on the sheet (which will be given out on the day) and return their form to school by **Thursday 2nd April**. All returned forms will be entered into a prize draw. Winning entries will receive a **£10 book voucher**, which children will be able to spend on a trip to Waterstones (during school time!).

Story Time- a story telling character from a well-known children's book will be visiting the school for our whole school story time assembly.

Please encourage your children to take part in what will be a fantastic day!
